



'GOING-ON' @ GYVLON

Stadthaus (London) Architect: Waugh Thistleton (London)

This nine-storey high-rise (constructed entirely in timber) is the tallest timber residential building in the world, all nine floors have the solid feel of **GYVLON**

Comprising private units for housebuilder Telford Homes and affordable housing for social housing provider Metropolitan Housing Trust, Stadthaus provides 29 apartments.



The building has been assembled using a cross-laminated timber panel system pioneered by manufacturers KLH of Austria and is akin to jumbo plywood, arriving on site in panels up to 13m in length.

Designed in collaboration with structural engineers Techniker, this is the first building in the world of this height to construct not only load-bearing walls and floor slabs but also stair and lift cores entirely from timber.

The entire nine-storey structure was up and built within nine weeks.
